



DATAETHICS e-training Enrollment guidelines

To enroll in the DATAETHICS e-training platform go to the page:

<https://ki.eu-west.catalog.canvaslms.com/browse/data-ethics>

We recommend that you first enroll for the DATAETHICS HUB. This will allow you to create your account in the Canvas LMS via the Canvas Catalog. We kindly ask you to double-check your spelling of your email and your account details to prevent problems logging into your account.

When you have enrolled for the HUB you must check your email account for an email titled “Welcome to Canvas Catalog for DATAETHICS courses”.

This email contains a link to register your account in the Canvas LMS where the courses are hosted. Please note that you should read this welcome mail **carefully** and use the link button at the bottom of the page to **Complete Registration** of your account. The welcome mail gives you important information on how to create your password.

Once you have enrolled for the HUB you can sign up for the first DATAETHICS course, using the same account that you have just created via the enrollment in the HUB.
